After Jesus's resurrection, how much time did he spend on the Earth?

You would find there was considerable time spent here. It would be approximating twenty-four months.

How much time did Jesus spend with his disciples, before they scattered?

He was not with them continuously, but would appear when needed. Ot would be some considerable time; about ten weeks, as we would judge time.

Did the ascension occur at the end of the twenty-four month, after the resurrection?

It would be closer to thirty-six than twenty-four months, when the period ended.

What was Jesus doing, during this period of time?

Firstly, there was the administration to those people who knew and loved Jesus. There was not the display of himself publicly. Farther away than the city of Jerusalem itself, there were selected groups that came to marvel, not as spectators, but as sincere spiritual seekers. Here, there was the continuation and the charging of the Law to the disciples, as each rose, in their own way, and gathered disciples about themselves, and spread the word (the Law of Love, you see). After separating from the disciples, there were visitations to other peoples about the planet; firstly, to the Asiatics, then to the Russians, and then the peoples of the northern regions (Eskimos, you might call them). There were visitations to those in South America (the Amazon area). There were visitations to the Mexican lands, Latin American areas. There were visitations also to the Indians, both the Aztec and the Huron, Blackfeet, and those nations of the red skins. Here, there was a demonstration to those points of influence, you see. The Aztecs, the Amazon, and others all brought together large congregations of people for the demonstration of the spiritual being in the flesh.

Would this account for the stories of the white-bearded saviour prevalent in many countries throughout the world?

Indeed, it does, for the entity, Jesus who attained the Christ-hood, the Christ Consciousness, visited these people as the Messiah, as that one who would bring and demonstrate love. He could not be harmed, and he was totally spiritual, yet he possessed a physical form. As such, he could be seen. He could perform spiritually through the flesh so that all could feel the miracle; the demonstration that each entity is possessed of a soul, a fragment of God, based, enriched, and engulfed as love.

These stories are seen as approximating this twenty-four months' period when the entity visited, demonstrated and then left the people. When there is the experience of the long hair, the beard, and the light, flowing robe or the walking on the water, then yes, would be the same one—the appearance of the Christ itself, while in the flesh; both in Christians and in tribal recollection. yes, to the question.
